NAVIGATING SALT LAKE CITY 73rd Western Poultry Disease Conference

A very economical way of getting to the Salt Lake City Marriott City Center hotel is to take the TRAX (light rail mass transit) Green Line from the Salt Lake International Airport to downtown. Fare is \$2.50 per person and will drop you off very close to the hotel. Get off at the Gallivan Plaza stop. (Map and schedule next page; also <u>https://www.rideuta.com/Rider-Tools/Schedules-and-Maps/704-Green-Line</u>)

The Green Line also has a free fare zone within downtown SLC. This is a convenient way to travel through the city center if walking is not desired. However, many venues in downtown SLC are accessible by foot from the hotel.




Temple Square (free): Historic Temple Square and the headquarters of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints are located in the heart of downtown Salt Lake City. While the Salt Lake temple is under renovation there are still many places you can visit on and near Historic Temple Square, including the Conference Center, Family Search Library, The Tabernacle, and The Church History Museum.


City Creek Center: The City Creek Center is a mixed-use development with an upscale openair shopping center, office and residential buildings, fountain, and simulated creek near Temple Square in downtown Salt Lake City.

Clark Planetarium (fee for admission and additional fees to see selected movies): The Clark Planetarium is a planetarium and science museum situated within The Gateway at the intersection of 400 West and 100 South in downtown Salt Lake City

FamilySearch Library (free): The FamilySearch Library, formerly the Family History Library, is a genealogical research facility in downtown Salt Lake City. The library is open to the public free of charge and is operated by FamilySearch, the genealogical arm of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.
